**SERVICE APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT**

Upon completion and submittal of this application and agreement, the Applicant agrees to comply with all terms and conditions of service. At this time, the Town of Awendaw Waterworks will provide water service to the Applicant with the above-referenced property. The applicant shall purchase and receive water service from the Town in accordance with the Town's Rates and Charges and other applicable service policies, if any, as may be amended from time to time. Furthermore:

- A **Residential** tap fee of \$1,500.00 plus materials shall be charged for all three-quarter or one-inch water taps. The fee is intended to reimburse the Town for costs incurred in making the tap and bringing the service to the right-of-way. **\*ADDITIONAL FEE FOR BORING UNDER THE ROAD \$ 2,750.00**
- A **Commercial** tap fee of \$2,500.00 plus materials shall be charged for all three-quarters or one-inch water taps. The fee is intended to reimburse the Town for costs incurred in making the tap and bringing the service to the right-of-way. **\*ADDITIONAL FEE FOR BORING UNDER THE ROAD \$ 3,000.00**
- The Town of Awendaw Waterworks' maintenance responsibility ends at the property line.
- All water furnished by the Town of Awendaw to the applicant shall be metered by a meter installed, owned, and maintained by the Town of Awendaw. The Town of Awendaw shall have the exclusive right to locate the property's water meter, pipeline, and appurtenant equipment to connect Applicant to the Town of Awendaw's water system. The meter and service connection are for the sole use of the applicant and are to provide service to only one (1) dwelling or one (1) business on the property.
- Applicant shall allow the Town of Awendaw access to the Town's meter, pipeline, or appurtenant equipment. The Town's meter, pipeline, or appurtenant equipment will be disconnected upon service to the Applicant.
- Applicants are strictly prohibited from tampering with the meter. Any person who intentionally or knowingly causes impairment or interruption of the Town of Awendaw's public water supply, or causes it to be diverted in any manner, shall be reported by the Town of Awendaw for possible prosecution under South Carolina Code of Laws section 16-13-385.
- Applicants shall install at Applicant's own expense any necessary service lines from the Town's meter to the point of use. It is specially understood and agreed by Applicant that the Town's responsibility for water quality and maintenance extends only from the public right-of-way to the meter base and that all use of water, contamination of water, maintenance of lines, material composition of lines and other related facilities on the customer's side of the meter base or meter is and shall remain the responsibility of the Applicant.
- It is illegal to connect the Town water supply AND a private line from a well or other source. There must be no connection between the two. Well water may be used for irrigation or other non-potable uses. DHEC will issue fines if both the Town and well water are connected to a residence.
